### Scenarios:

The scenario is a form of improvised role-play in which the clinical care of the patient is practised. Role-play involves participants acting out roles that represent real situations, in a structured and safe environment. Scenarios encourage the integration of knowledge, skills and decision-making while offering you the opportunity to practice a range of responses to a given situation, thus increasing your repertoire of behaviours.

### Formative Assessment

Candidates are assessed throughout the course so that appropriate feedback is documented on your **performance assessment sheet**. Each participant may go through their feedback form at the end of each day. If you have any concerns, please contact coordinator or the course Director on that day.

#### Day 1 formative assessment includes:

- basic life support skills
- rhythm recognition and safe defibrillation
- advanced airway skills

#### Day 2 ☑ Summative Assessment

- Multiple choice question paper (pass mark 70%). Post course MCQ paper will appear in your email on survey monkey format.
- The interaction with the manikin will be assessed by the respective instructors during a simulated scenario situation which may be cardiac, illness or trauma. Performance index is calculated based on the interaction. In order to qualify for the certificate, this should be more than 40%.
